




Getting Started with the Park Atlas

Park Atlas Web Viewer Job Aide Series


- To start interacting with the map, use the **Zoom Slider** tool in the upper left-hand section of the Map window. Click on the **Zoom In** button  or the **Zoom Out** button  to adjust the scale of the map. To **Pan** [move your view] click and drag using the mouse.
- To change what information is displayed on the map, click the **Map Layers** button  on the bottom of the *Home* view. When the *Map Layers* view is opened you can then pick a **Map Theme** using the drop down menu at the top of the *Map Layers* view.

Map Themes

- **Basic Data** theme will show you a number of essential overview elements for the park: roads, trails, visitor center, legislative boundary and more.
- **Visitor Use** theme include points or places of interest such as: trails, parking, pullouts, access points, campgrounds, recreational data, overlooks, and sometimes geologic arches, or wilderness.
- **Facilities** theme can include elements such as: utilities, bridges, fuel locations, parking lots, and buildings.
- **Natural Resources** theme will show you the essential resources for the Park which may include, but are not limited to: hydrology, vegetation, geology, and wildlife.
- **Cultural Resources** theme will vary according to each park but may include elements such as cemeteries, historic structures, archeology sites, and survey areas.
- **All Data** is a theme that allows you to see all of the data layers that were used in each of the themes. This is the “kitchen sink” theme and includes all of the available options.
- Other themes can be introduced based on the data available for any specific park.



- When you want to do an action click the **I want to...**  drop down menu and select the action you want to take such as:
 - Find data on the map
 - Turn map data on/off
 - Return to the initial map extent
 - Print
 - Bookmark the current map extent



- On the Home view there are links to a feedback form and an email for comments or help, if you need more information.
